#### Student Recitals

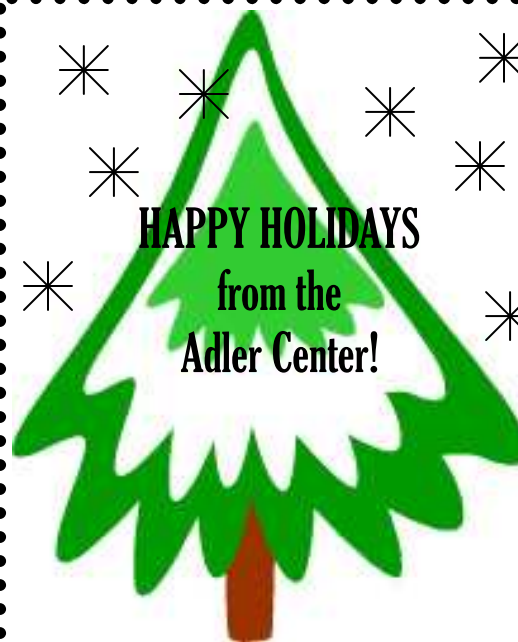
