### Suzuki Violin

Suzuki violin class is for young children aged 3-6 years accompanied by parent or guardian. Students learn about the violin through its exploration and the foundations of music in fun and creative ways. They build and grow musically while being supported by their peers through positive reinforcement. Parental involvement is paramount for the child to succeed. Their support and direction during daily practice and listening ensure the student maintains the correct techniques presented to them during their sessions with the teacher. Classes meet once a week for 40 minutes based on student age and skill level. Students are strongly encouraged to participate in private lessons to maximize their development.
