

# Camp Adler Classes 2012 – Session II

## 1st Period Classes

### ART

#### Scenery and Set Design

Before the curtain rises and the spotlights shine down on the actors, designers spend years envisioning the creative concepts behind some of the world's most beautiful theatres and stages, as well as designing the sets that bring stories to life. Using multimedia techniques, students will explore the fundamentals of scenery and set design: bringing his or her unique ideas into the design concepts and creation of the scenery and backdrop for Camp Adler's Musical! The musical will be performed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12**

#### Art Explorer

Budding artists will explore a wide variety of art media from making a clay pot to a wood sculpture. Some other projects may include wire sculpture, metal relief, painting and printmaking. Prepare to get messy! Projects are displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

#### Messy Artists!

Aspiring artists will have a lot of fun creating art in a variety of media. Campers will create crafts, sculptures, paintings, and drawings, and should be sure to wear old clothes, and bring their smocks! Parents won't want to miss seeing what all the fun was about when projects are displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

### MUSIC/ DRAMA

#### Camp Adler Musical

Want to sing and dance on stage? This is the perfect chance for campers to showcase their Broadway talents! Students will learn several aspects of creating a musical including acting, singing and dancing. They can choose to either be an actor, a singer or both! Students are introduced to the tools necessary for strong story telling and performance through the use of theatre games, exercises and practical performance experiences. No experience necessary! The musical will be performed at Celebration of the Arts!

#### Guitar Ensemble

(6-9 years) Guitar ensemble will provide campers experienced on the guitar with the opportunity to focus on playing as an ensemble. Music will be specially arranged for this unique ensemble who will present at Celebration of the Arts! **Campers should have some prior experience on the guitar. Limit 5.**

### ARCHITECTURE

#### Beginning Architecture/History

Explore how shapes become the elements of all building design, learn how to draw floor plans and how a building is constructed and translating that into a drawing. Study and learn examples of ancient architecture, Greek, Roman, Medieval and Renaissance through the current designs of contemporary architects. Plenty of "hands-on" projects will reinforce the historic and innovation design concepts studied. Your architecture drawings will be unveiled at the Celebration of the Arts Day. **Limit 10**

## 2nd Period Classes

### ART

#### Mobile Magic

Soar through the air as we make art that hangs from above! Campers will create three dimensional mobiles using a variety of materials, from a decorative dreamcatcher to mobiles inspired by nature. All mobiles will spiral in the wind at Celebration of the Arts. **Limit 12.**

#### Mixed Media Extravaganza!

Aspiring artists will have lots of fun creating artwork in a variety of media. You will create crafts, sculptures, paintings, and drawings. Remember to wear old clothes and bring your smocks! Parents won't want to miss seeing what all the fun was about when your projects are displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

#### Messy ArtSCAPE!

Do you love being outside? Do you love to make art? Then put your love of nature and creativity together! Campers will learn about art and the environment while creating fabulous works of art using nature as our medium as well as inspiration. We will adventure outdoors (weather permitting) to create artwork using what we find. We'll also take safaris through Camp Adler's own jungle and then create animals to fill it. Remember to be sure to wear old clothes and bring your smocks! Your family will love the world we created at Celebration of the Arts. **Limit 12.**

### MUSIC

#### Garage Band

Drums, guitars and trash cans, oh my! Students will come together using whatever instrument they have to create a one time only, garage band style ensemble. They will learn the basics of rock style rhythms by learning notes and techniques while having fun putting a band together with their peers.

#### Beginning Piano

This class is specifically for those campers looking for an introduction to the piano. In addition to learning the basics, campers will study piano skills including 5 finger patterns, scales, and familiar songs to showcase for their families at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 5.**

#### Adler Guitars

(10-13 years) Adler Guitars will provide campers with the opportunity to focus on playing as an ensemble. Music will be specially arranged for this unique ensemble who will present its exciting music at Celebration of the Arts. **Limit 6.**

### DRAMA

#### Sketch Comedy

Make 'em Laugh! Learn to write and perform your own comedy sketches. Campers will develop individual comedic characters and create situations in order to develop short comedy scenes. Scenes will be written using various improvisational techniques. All this comedy will be seen at Celebration of the Arts!

## 3rd Period Classes

### ART

#### Clay Creations

Use your imagination to create with clay. We will be creating art through clay sculpting using our fingers, hands, and simple tools. Techniques will be demonstrated in order for you to make imaginative masterpieces. Campers will explore the world of possibilities; using pinch, coil, and basic slab building methods. Come create with clay! Artwork will be displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

#### Create with the Masters

In this interactive art history class students will learn about the great masters and create their own versions or famous works. Luckily at camp there are no tests or papers to write, just art to create! Picasso, Van Gogh, Grant Wood, and Jackson Pollock are just a few of the many artists that will be studied. This class will strengthen students drawing and painting skills as well as helping them connect to artists of the past. Artwork will be displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

#### Jewelry Making

Learn how to make real jewelry! This beginning Jewelry class you will learn techniques such as beading, glass work, wire work, bead stringing, and much more! Your jewelry will be displayed at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 12.**

### MUSIC

#### Rockin' Band Rhythms

Bring your instrument and get ready to improve your playing skills in a whole new way! Build new friendships while playing rhythm and technique games. **This class is open to anyone with at least one year of playing experience on a band instrument.** Students will even have an opportunity to write their own song! Come prepared to be a band rock star and don't forget your instrument, reeds (if necessary) and any music you want to work on improving. Students will rock their new talents at Celebration of the Arts!

#### Piano Introduction

This class is specifically for those campers looking for an introduction to the piano. In addition to learning the basics, campers will study piano skills including 5 finger patterns, scales, and familiar songs to showcase for their families at Celebration of the Arts! **Limit 5.**

### DRAMA

#### Improv for Beginners: Adler Center Comedy

Do you like to laugh and have a goofy ole time? In this crash course guide to improv, students will be laughing their way through the building blocks of improvisation and the techniques of successful scene work. Through playful interactive theatre games and storytelling, students are introduced to the elements of spontaneity, listening, accepting and responding. This methodology helps students access their imagination, free their inhibitions and increase their confidence. No experience necessary! Campers will then showcase their new Improv skills at Celebration of the Arts!

## 4th Period Classes

### ART

#### Adler Mural

Be a LARGE part of Camp Adler by making large artwork! We will learn about the collaborative steps of designing and painting several large murals to be displayed at Celebration of the Arts. In this session you will also have fun making some backgrounds for Celebration of the Arts. Learn to paint large and be part of Camp Adler's official "Mural Crew".

#### Drawsketch

Venture into drawing and sketching! Campers will be guided through a series of fun ways to draw enhancing their creative abilities. Simple drawing tools will be used. This class focuses on drawing by using wet materials such as ink, watercolors, acrylics, markers and dry materials such as charcoal, graphite, and conte' crayons. Come prepared to express your creativity! Parents come join your camper at the "Celebration of the Arts," where we will display your drawings. **Limit 12.**

#### Wizard Magic

Be whisked away into a faraway realm where wizards, dragons and knights in their castles come alive! Art projects will be based on a medieval theme using drawing, painting and crafts. Create your own legend! Parents come join your prince or princess at the "Celebration of the Arts," where we will display all our magical creations. **Limit 12.**

### MUSIC

#### Musical Explorers

Explore the wonderful world of music while creating your own composition. Campers will learn the essential elements of the music world and at the same time, apply that knowledge while exercising their creativity through songwriting. Camper's compositions will be performed at Celebration of the Arts.

#### Camp Adler Voices

This course will give students an understanding of the voice and its physical components as applied to musical theatre and choir settings. Students work on fundamentals of healthy singing: breath support, articulation, relaxation techniques, alignment and proper construction/placement. Included in this course is a basic introduction to music theory and its application including: note values, scales, intervals, harmony, key signatures, and sight-reading. Students who take this class are also encouraged to sing up for Music Theater for more practice and fun! Camper's will perform at Celebration of the Arts.
