Responsibilities:

- Develop and teach classes in leadership skills, working with children, and in social and civic responsibility.
- Develop lesson plans for each class.
- Supervise junior counselors as they work with campers during Tribe Time, lunch time, and in their classrooms.
- Communicate enthusiastically with the Juniors, Faculty, Tribe Leaders, and Camp Directors through hourly check-ins, and verbal and written feedback.
- Communicate enthusiastically with the Program Coordinator to ensure the growth of the Junior Tribe Leader Program.
- Run all aspects of the Junior program, including the supervision of personal projects, and the organization of special workshops and activities.
- Develop supply inventory for projects. Request orders for any necessary supplies within budget from Program Coordinator.
- Maintain assigned classroom space for damage and cleanliness. Report any and all concerns about rooms to Camp Director.
- Attend mandatory pre-camp meetings and orientation.

Celebration of the Arts:

- Attend Celebration of the Arts. This will be the last Thursday of each 3-week session lasting until approximately 8:30 pm.
- Assist the Camp Director and Program Coordinator in planning the Celebration of the Arts
- Assign specific tasks and responsibilities to each Junior and ensure they complete their duties.
- Keep watch over Juniors and campers during Celebration activities
